In line with the 2010 Bribery Act that came into force in July 2011, Mettex is committed to a zero-tolerance policy on any matters of bribery. Potential risks to bribery have been identified and scored accordingly, actions to address these risks have been created and these actions will be monitored & reviewed annually to ensure they are sufficient in dealing with the risks identified.
